1. Valentin Fleur Chenin Blanc - Vin de Pays du Val de Loire

Attractive fruity Loire Chenin with nice citrus fruit character and good balance.

Perfect to drink with simple seafood dishes.

2. Ocean Point Chardonnay - Australia

This wine is a blend of cool climate regions specializing in Chardonnay production.

The wine is unoaked and has light tropical fruit flavours and a nice clean finish.

3. La Pintora Sauvignon Blanc - Chile

4. Prahova Valley Merlot Rosé - Romania

Fresh and lively with good fruit character and a touch of spice.

Delicious refreshing rose, but with excellent fruit.

5. Orchid Boulevard White Zinfandel Rosé - California

Attractive salmon pink colour. Pleasant floral bouquet with soft fruit characters.

54. Mœt et Chandon Brut Impérial

Pale gold in colour with creamy, biscuity aromas, good depth and concentration, lively but with a soft, dry finish. £34.95

55. Veuve Clicquot Demi-Sec

Rich and intense on the nose with a sweet yet refreshing palate and soft, smooth finish. £37.50

51. Beaujolais Cave de Bel-Air - Burgundy

Bright ruby in appearance, delightful and fresh, this is a well made wine full of juicy Gamay fruit flavours. £12.50

ROSE

52. Marqués de Cáceres Rosado - Rioja, Spain

An intense bouquet of strawberries, raspberries and redcurrants. Fleshy fruit flavours, lively, fresh and elegant with balanced acidity. £10.50

WHITE

53. Chablis Château de Viviers - Chablis

An excellent mouthfilling Chablis with enough fruit to balance the clean, steely dryness that is typical of this wine. £19.50

RED

6. Olive Hills Nero d'Avola di Sicilia - Italy

Attractive rich red wine from Sicily. Good berry fruit character on the nose.

The taste is full and fruity with rich flavour.

Perfect with lamb chops, meaty pizza or just on its own.

7. Orange Street Ruby Cabernet / Merlot - South Africa

Good ruby red colour typical of Ruby Cabernet. The taste has good blackcurrant fruit and mint character with nice soft tannins and structure from the Merlot.

8. Orchid Boulevard Merlot - California

Soft black cherry aroma with a touch of green olives and rhubarb. The flavour has smooth berry fruit character and soft tannins. Easy drinking.

9. J Verrier Brut NV - Champagne

A richly coloured Champagne made predominantly from the Pinot Noir grape.

It has a fine, lasting mousse with attractive bready, yeasty characteristics on both the nose and palate with a touch of citrus fruit.

WHITE WINE

10. Chablis La Colombe - Chablis

Delicious example of this classic dry white. Very good concentration and balance with mineral character and good length. £28.50

11. Chablis 1er Cru Vaucopins Château de Viviers - Chablis 2005/06

A dry, crisp, elegant Chablis with developing Chardonnay character of tropical fruits and a soft, rounded finish. £38.00

12. Rully Blanc Lupe-Cholet - Burgundy

Pale lemon in colour with nice mineral and peach characters on the nose. The taste is quite complex with good depth and length of flavour. Excellent example of quality white Burgundy. £30.00

13. Meursault Lupe-Cholet - Burgundy

Pale gold in appearance with a soft, fragrant bouquet. The palate is dry and medium in body with a hint of tropical fruit leading to a rich, full bodied creamy finish. £53.50

14. Sancerre Domaine Moulin Granger - Loire

Classic Sancerre style, more herbaceous and grassy than gooseberry with lovely mineral flavours. Well balanced with a nice length of flavour. £25.50

CHAMPAGNE

47. Laurent Perrier Cuvée Rosé NV

A delicate rose, light and refreshing with flowery, fragrant character and hints of summer fruits on both the nose and palate. Perfect for any romantic occasion. £72.95

48. Möet et Chandon Grand Vintage 2000/04

A medium gold wine with a nose already revealing aromas of dried fruits and toast combined with warm honey notes and a long, harmonious finish. £67.00

49. Veuve Clicquot Vintage 2002/03

Aromatic pureness and fine complexity with floral notes and hints of hazelnut and almond, mingling with warmer notes of fresh pastries, apricot and ripe peaches enhanced by just a hint of mint leaf. £72.00

50. Dom Pérignon 2000

One of Champagne's most outstanding wines. Refined with a palate showing layers of yeasty, nutty flavours. The aristocrat of fine vintage Champagnes. £137.00

43. Mercier Brut NV

*Light refreshing style of Champagne, very popular in France.
Well balanced, stylish and perfect as an aperitif. £43.50*

44. Mercier Brut Rosé NV

*Light, elegant Champagne with good fruit and balance.
Perfect aperitif. £47.95*

45. Mœt et Chandon Brut Imperial NV

*Pale gold in colour with creamy, biscuity aromas, good depth and
concentration, lively but with a soft, dry finish. £55.45*

46. Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut NV

*Elegantly golden with a deep biscuity nose. A wine with
plenty of fruit, dry with fine balance and style. Presented
in the distinctive yellow labelled bottle. £57.95*



WHITE WINE

15. Vouvray Ackerman - Loire

*Medium sweet, fresh, clean and fragrant with white flower aromas
and a crisp, refreshing palate. £18.00*

16. Condrieu Grand Chaillees, Domaine du Monteillet - Rhone 2006/07

*From the greatest white wine appellation in the entire Rhone Valley, this Viognier
has an exotic and heady bouquet of luscious perfumed fruit which continues
through to the perfectly balanced, elegant palate of peaches and apricots,
giving the impression of sweetness despite it's refreshing dryness. £66.00*

17. Marques de Caceres Blanco - Rioja, Spain

*An intense bouquet on the nose with fresh aromas of pears,
acacia flowers and mineral notes. Lusciously rich in the mouth where a pleasant
balance and fullness brings out fresh, long lasting flavours. £16.50*

18. Pinot Grigio Bottega Vinai - Trentino, Italy

*Made from Pinot Grigio grapes from the Laghi Valley this is a delicious example of
fine Pinot Grigio. Concentrated fruit on the nose and palate.
The taste has a lovely mineral character with good length and structure. £23.00*

WHITE WINE

19. Tyrrell's Moore's Creek Chardonnay - Australia

Pale straw in colour with rich, distinct varietal fruit character on the nose. On the palate citrus and peach fruit flavours are balanced with subtle oak integration and a crisp, refreshing finish. £18.50

20. Peter Lehmann Reserve Semillon - Barossa Valley, Australia

The Margaret Barossa Semillon is made from the very best Semillon of the vintage. When young, these wines are delicate and stylish with steely acidity. They mature slowly in the bottle, developing characteristic honey on the palate while still retaining their tight, firm, reserved structure. £26.50

21. Babich Black Label Sauvignon Blanc - Marlborough, New Zealand

Pale lemon gold in appearance with a clean, fresh varietal fruit nose. The palate is medium in body with crisp, refreshing gooseberry fruit character and a hint of herbaceousness. A lovely wine with finesse on the finish. £22.50

22. Concha y Toro Sauvignon Blanc - Chile

Excellent Sauvignon fruit character and a grassy aroma delivering a mouthful of fruit combined with balanced acidity and a long finish. £17.50

DESSERT WINE

39. Concha y Toro - Chile

Late Harvest Sauvignon Blanc 37.5cl

Brilliant golden yellow in appearance with bright, amber notes. The nose is full of ripe papaya and peach with underlying honeyed characteristics. The palate is luscious but fruity with good balancing, refreshing acidity that carries through on the long finish. £18.50

40. Sauternes - Bordeaux

Clos Dady 37.5cl

A golden, intense and powerfully complex wine, rich in texture with masses of ripe pineapple, peach, apricot and strawberry fruit and creamy vanilla character with a delicious honeyed sumptuousness that is both spicy and complex. £31.00

SPARKLING WINE

41. Ackerman Saumur Brut Rosé 1811 - Loire

A refreshing, sparkling rose wine made in the Loire Valley. Deep salmon pink in colour with a freshly scented nose and red berry fruit character on the palate leading to a smooth finish with a lasting sparkle. £25.50

42. Prosecco Spumante Piu

Extra Dry NV - Italy

Light, refreshing sparkling wine from Northern Italy. Made from the Prosecco grape the flavour is fragrant and delicate with soft fruit flavours of apples and white peaches. Perfect as an aperitif. £24.50

ROSE WINE

36. Marqués de Cáceres Rosado - Rioja, Spain

Vivid pale raspberry in appearance with an impressive, intense bouquet of strawberries, raspberries and redcurrants.

Deliciously rich in the mouth with fleshy fruit flavours that are full and luscious. A lively, fresh and elegant wine with balanced acidity. £21.00

37. Concha y Toro Merlot Rosé- Chile

A beautiful salmon pink wine with intense, fruity aromas on the nose.

The palate is fresh, crisp and youthful with an abundance of ripe strawberry fruit flavours and a smooth, balanced finish. £18.50

38. Geoff Merrill Grenache Rosé- McLaren Vale, Australia

A wine with a delightful deep pink appearance and a bouquet and palate full of fresh, ripe strawberries.

A truly wonderful New World rosé wine. £21.00

RED WINE

23. Ginestet St. Emilion, Château Perey - Bordeaux

Deep garnet in appearance, this wine has a rich, intense nose that leads into a palate that is balanced and well rounded with plenty of dark berry fruits and subtle, well integrated tannins. £24.00

24. Chateau d'Arsac, Cru Bourgeois Margaux - Bordeaux 2004/05

Intense garnet-red in colour with a toasty, smoky nose, opening up to reveal a generous bouquet of red fruits. Silky and seductive palate, structured but rounded, with a concentrated middle and a flourish of vanilla and blackcurrant on the finish. The individual varietals are harvested and vinified separately and aged in a selection of new and used French barriques. £59.50

25. Fleurie La Chapelle de Bois - Beaujolais

The most popular of the Beaujolais Crus, this attractive ruby coloured wine has soft berry fruit and floral aromas on the nose and a rich palate showing redcurrant fruit character. £25.00

26. Gevrey Chambertin Pierre Bouree & Fils - Burgundy 2001/03

A classic Burgundy wine from one of the most famous villages of the Cotes de Nuits.

This wine has defined Pinot Noir character showing good strawberry fruit and earthy notes with firm body and good structure leading to an elegant soft finish. £41.00

27. Châteauneuf du Pape Vicomte de Lignac, Ogier - Rhone

Delicious, warm, rich fruit flavours typical of Grenache and Chateauneuf.

Excellent quality with soft supple tannins. Very good wine from a specialist Chateauneuf producer. Drinking well now. £36.00

RED WINE

28. Montresor Valpolicella Classico - Italy

Rich ruby in appearance with a nose of iris, violet and sweet almond. The palate is full in body with velvety cherry fruit flavours enhanced by a hint of oak and a soft, well rounded finish. £21.00

29. Chianti Classico, Villa la Pagliaia - Italy

Super quality Chianti Classico with intense aromas of strawberries and raisins on the nose. The taste is full bodied and rounded with good balance and excellent length of flavour. £26.00

**30. Barolo Gigi Rosso, Cascina Arione Serralunga - Italy
2004/06**

Powerful and full bodied with cherry fruit and spice on the nose and rich, concentrated fruit, firm tannins and balanced acidity on the palate. £32.50

31. Nuviana Tempranillo / Cabernet Sauvignon - Spain

Vibrant ruby red in appearance with intense, elegant berry fruit aromas on the nose. The palate is bursting with delicious red berry fruits combined with subtle oak characters and a long, lingering finish. £22.50

32. Marqués de Cáceres Reserva - Rioja, Spain

Deep ruby red in appearance, the bouquet is elegant with rich cherry and raspberry fruit aromas and a touch of fine oak. The palate is full and fleshy with well balanced, delicious red fruit character and velvety, soft, ripe tannins. £30.00

RED WINE

33. Tyrrell's Moore's Creek Shiraz - Australia

Deep ruby in appearance with ripe plum characteristics evident on the nose. The palate is medium in body and elegant with rich fruit flavours, spicy notes and subtle, balanced tannins supported by a long, lasting finish. £18.50

34. Babich Cabernet Merlot - Hawkes Bay, New Zealand

Herbaceous black berry fruit aromas on the nose. Balanced tannins, a touch of spice and an abundance of ripe blackcurrant. £21.50

35. Concha y Toro Merlot - Chile

Unoaked and bursting with red and black berry fruits, soft and warm on the palate and medium bodied with balanced length. £17.50
